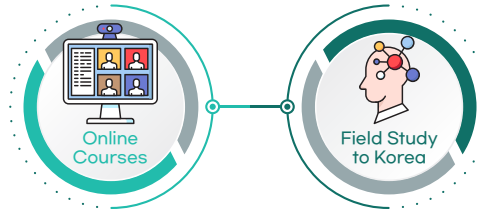

- Currently employed or actively serving as a leader, change agent, or facilitator in global development or G20-related matters
- Minimum of three years of work experience in the public sector
- Fluency in English
- Able to attend live streaming courses and travel to Korea (if travel restrictions permit it)

► Points will be added for those with a recommendation letter from:

- Embassy in Korea
 - Director General level or above from Government Ministry
 - Alumni of the Global Leadership Program
- *Note: Only one recommendation letter can be applied.*
