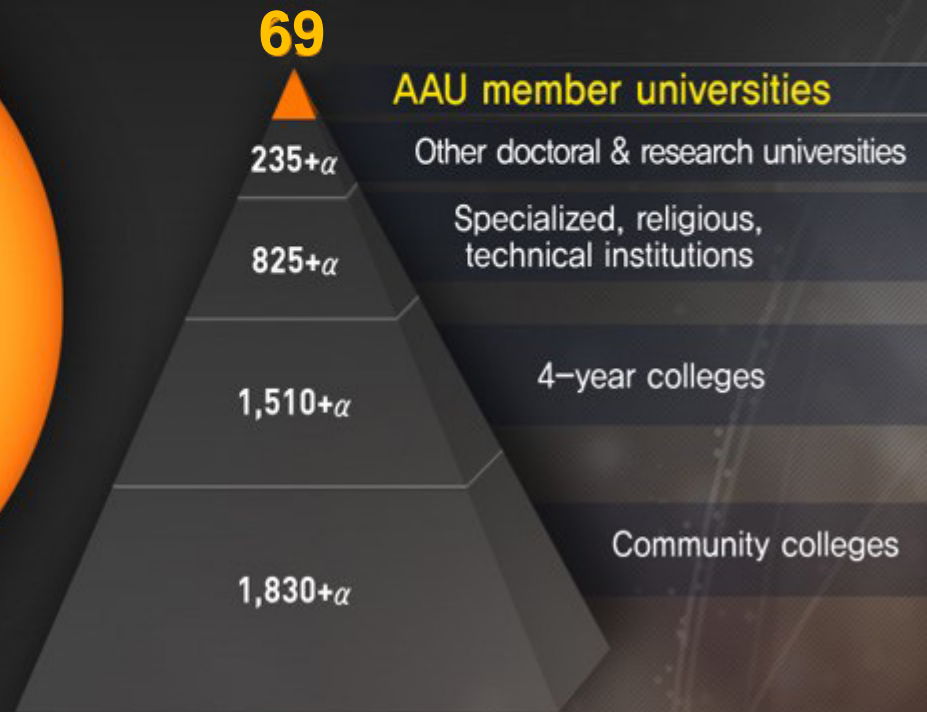

- 4th largest city in Missouri

Admission Process



- Online application and application fee payment for Graduate School
- Send other materials to Graduate School (transcripts, 3 recommendation letters, official financial support letter, TOEFL score, resume, statement of interest)
- Go to Truman School application website (<https://truman.missouri.edu/degree-programs/master-public-affairs-mpa>)
- Send the application materials by September 1st
- Truman School will admit applicants by September 30th
- Graduate School will admit applications by October 15th
- Visa Type is J-1 Student Visa and MU will issue DS-2019 form
- Departure for Missouri: December 20 – December 31
- Truman school will start orientation and classes around January 15th
- TOEFL 80 (minimum; with no section score below 17), IELTS 6.5 (with no section score below 6), Pearson Test (59), Cambridge (180), Duolingo (105)
- Conditional admission if score (sub score) is below the requirement

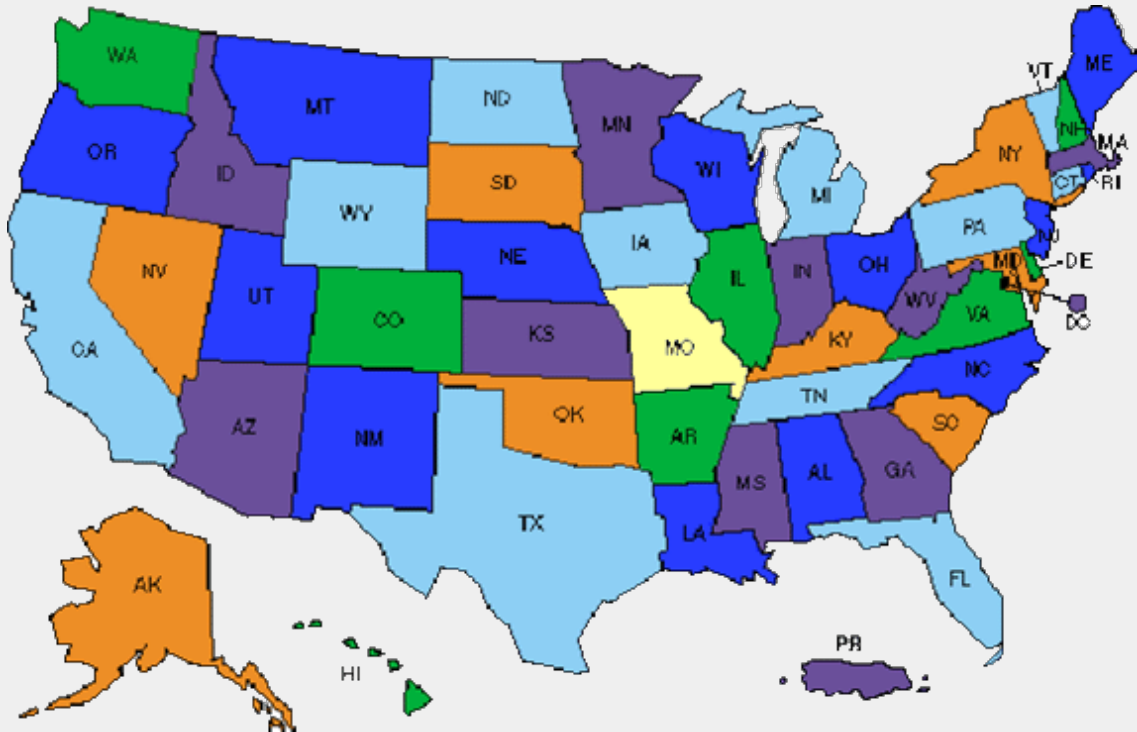

1. 공항 도착 픽업

- ▶ 미주리 콜럼비아 공항(COU) 도착 픽업 제공
 - 미리 집 주인에게 집 열쇠를 수령, 공항 도착 후 거주지로 이동
 - 당일 필요한 물,음식 등 간단한 장보기 후 집으로 이동
 - 12인승밴 혹은 미니밴으로 가족단위 픽업시 넉넉한 공간 제공
- ▶ 다만, 타 공항(세인트루이스) 도착시, 본인이 MO-X 셔틀버스를 이용하거나 렌터카로 콜럼비아에 이동(본인부담)
 - 콜럼비아 도착시간에 맞추어 거주지에서 센터 직원 대기하여, 당일 필요한 물, 식료품 등 간단한 장보기

6. 스마트폰

▶ 선불폰(한국)

미국내 무제한 통화 + 메시지, 요금별 데이터 차등 사용
- PhoneUSA의 경우, 최초 발신 10개 번호로 국제전화 무제한 등

- 한국에서 스마트폰 개통시 PhoneUSA 외 다양한 업체의 요금제를 비교,
선택하여 개통이 가능

6. 스마트폰

▶ 선불폰(미국)

- 미국에서 AT&T나 T-Mobile 통신사 요금은 Mint나 Visible 통신사보다 비싸지만 휴대전화 수신 가능 지역이 넓고 속도도 더 빠른 편입니다.

※ 한국에서 사용 중인 전화기를 미국에서 사용하려면 SIM 카드만 교체하여 통화할 수 있는 언락(unlock)을 꼭 해오셔야 합니다.

※ 삼성 최신폰으로 AT&T 이용시 제대로 작동되지 않은 경우가 발생하고 있습니다.

iPhone은 대부분의 통신사 이용시 문제점은 발생하지 않고 있습니다.

7. 공립 학교

▶ English Language (EL) TEST
