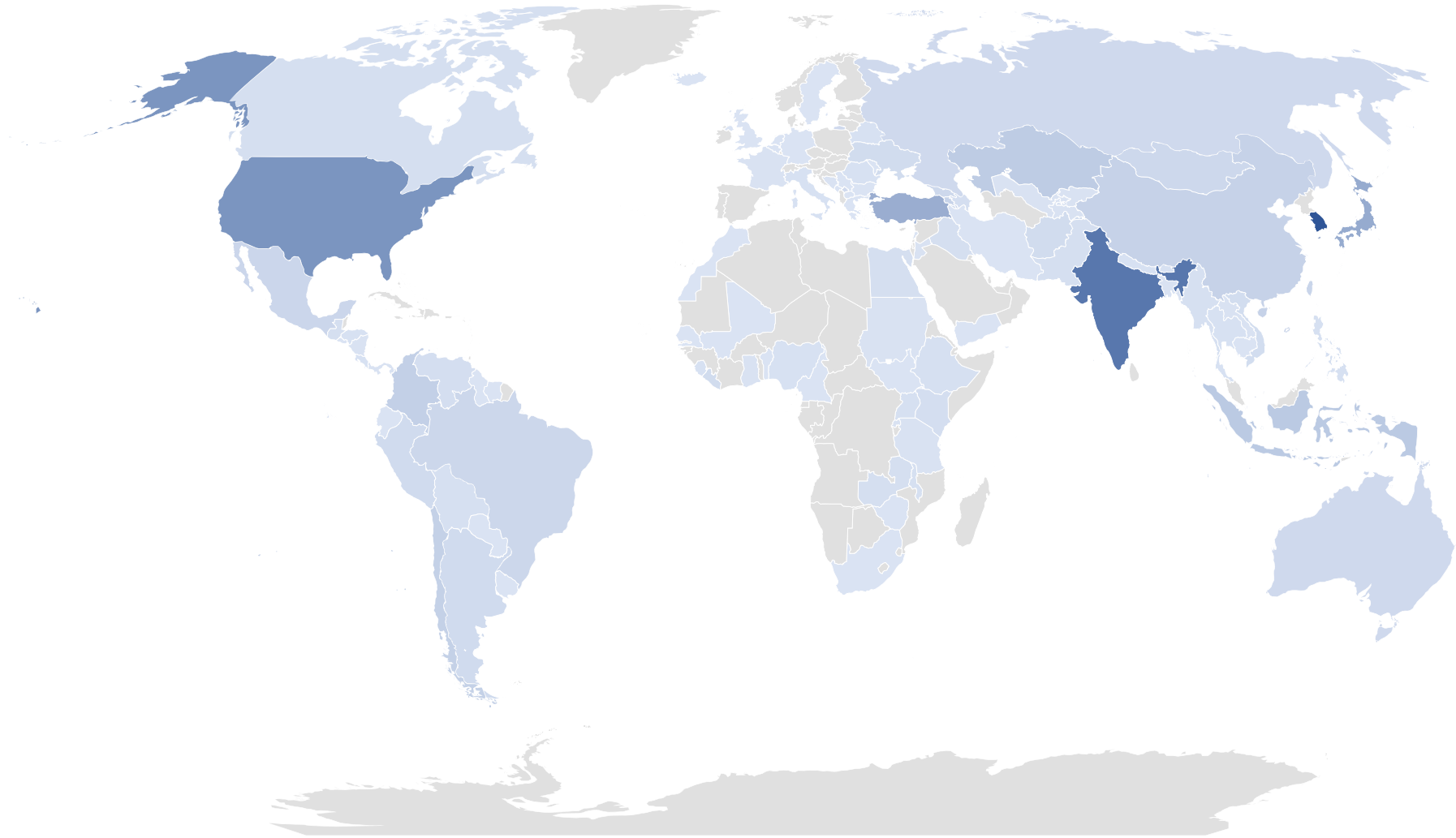





Employment Upon
